Objectives of Title 1

- Increase academic performance
- Provide educational support to students
- Increase parent and community involvement

What is Title 1?

- Title 1 is a 100% Federally funded supplemental education program.
- It provides financial assistance to those schools who qualify to improve educational opportunities.
- Title 1 programs are designed to help students meet state standards.

What is Title 1? (Cont)

- In buildings with 40% or more poverty, the LEAs can use funds for the curriculum and school programs
- In buildings with less than 40% poverty, programs are designed to help specific children.

Funding and Uses

- Title 1 funding is based on the school's socioeconomic status, and we qualify.
- Provide Professional Development to make sure our staff has the skills to increase student achievement.
- Purchase consumables to help teachers implement standards in the English curriculum.

Funding and Uses II

- Provide supplemental educational services to students who are considered “at risk” based on school improvement requirements.
- Increase parent involvement.

Parent Rights

- Federal funds are used therefore you as a taxpayer have rights.
- Each year we provide each family/student with a copy of the Franklin Towne Student Handbook.
